Scholarship

Red Mask Players has announced plans to present the nineteenth annual Jean Lewis Scholarship to a student planning a career in theater or a related area such as speech, oral interpretation, or radio-television. Area high school seniors, college, and community college students are eligible to apply.

Auditions and interviews with the scholarship committee will be held at the theater in April or May with the winner to be announced soon after.

Application blanks and additional information are available from the guidance counselors and speech teachers at area high schools and from Danville Area Community College communications department. The deadline for filing an application is March 31, 1995, and students are encouraged to apply just as soon as possible.

The scholarship is named for Jean Lewis, who directed all 37 of the Children's Theater productions from 1962 through 1986. The scholarship committee includes: Sue Ann Crick, Donna Sant, Bill Schatz, Jim Stuart, and Evelyn Miller, Chairman.

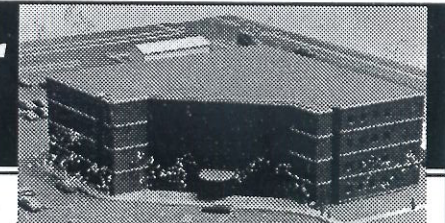
Ed Devore (Producer/Morgan Richards)

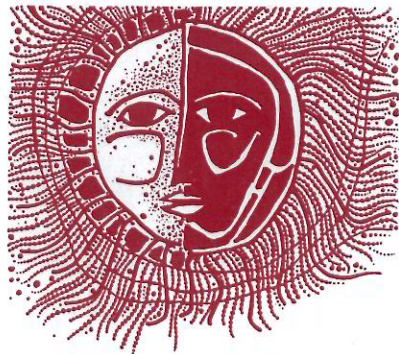

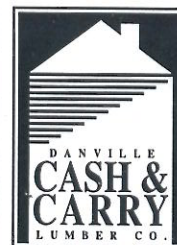

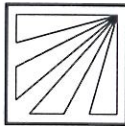
