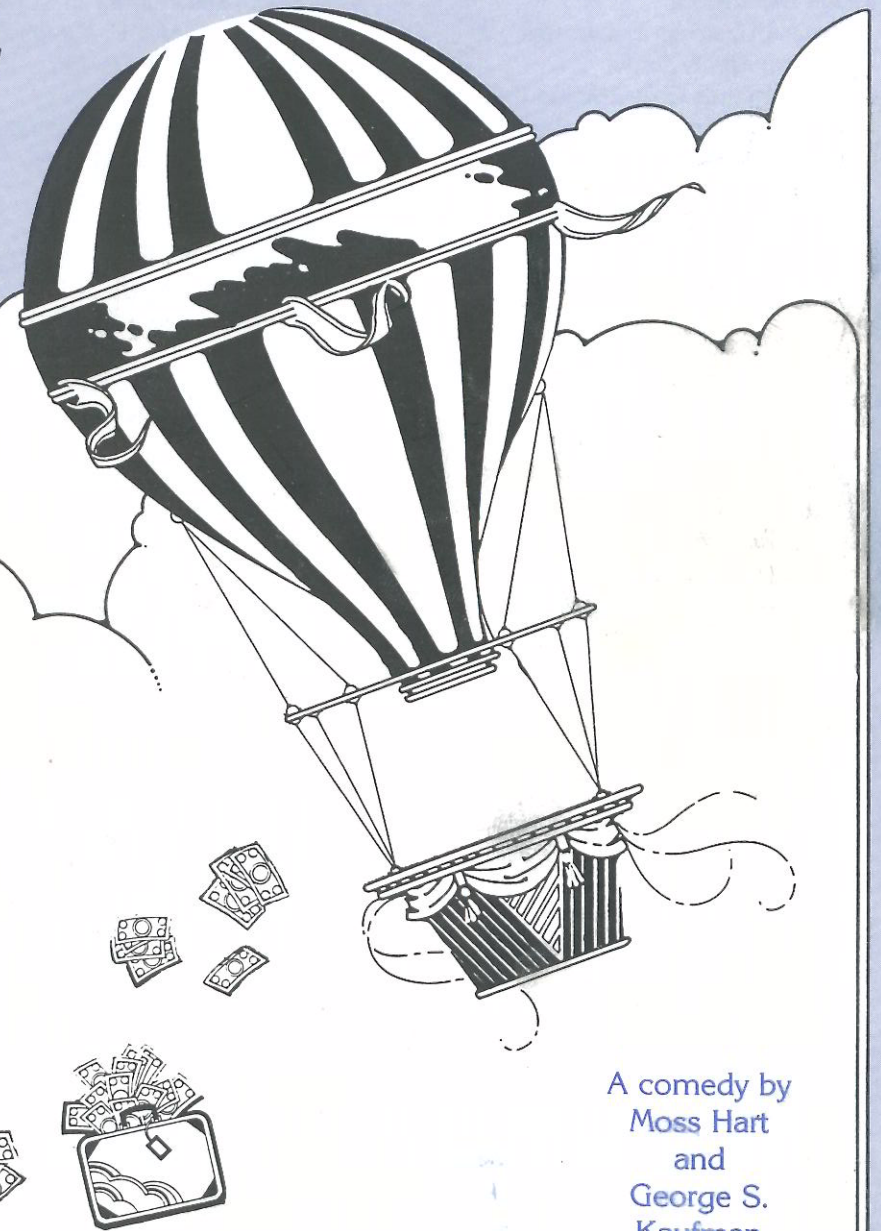

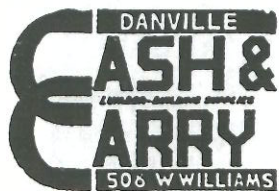

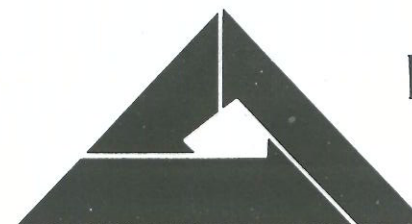

As treasurer of Red Mask and a "part-time substitute" bookkeeper at Danville Cash and Carry Lumber, Marty "sums up" her life as busy. She and husband Dave have 2 children—John (a junior at DHS) and Meg (a sophomore at The National Academy of Arts).

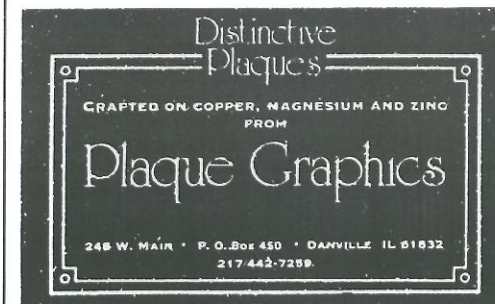

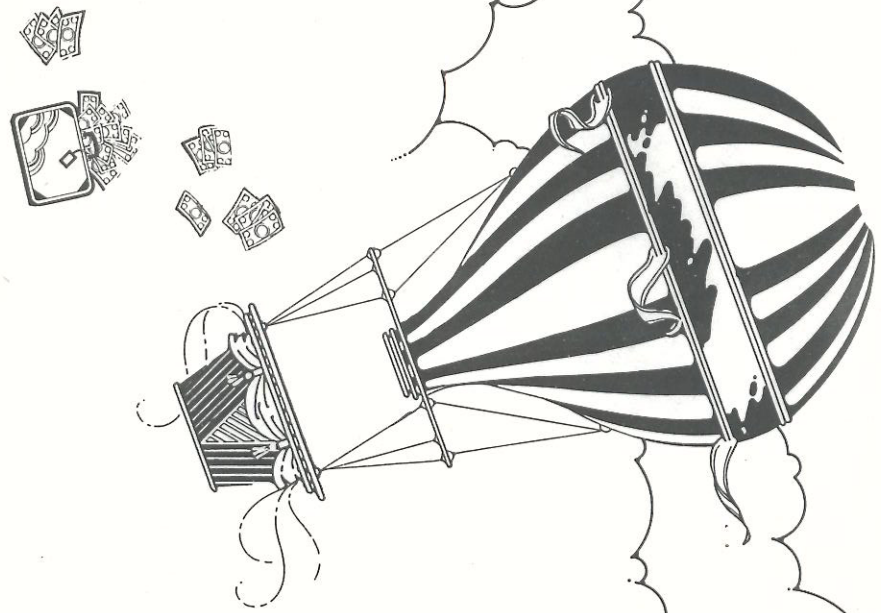
Pretzels Written by Jane Curtain, Judy Kahan & Fred Grandy
