

The late, great film critic (and Urbana native) Roger Ebert once said of movies:

"[They are] the most powerful empathy machine in all the arts...I can live somebody else's life for a while. I can walk in somebody else's shoes. I can see what it feels like to be a member of a different gender, a different race, a different economic class, to live in a different time, to have a different belief."


The same could be said of theatre. The script for *Ordinary People* elicits our empathy by focusing on the struggles of regular folks with whom we can identify. In fact, these characters may hit too close to home for some of us. Then again, audience identification -- even if it's uncomfortable -- is one of the most powerful functions of theatre.

To me, the conflicts which resonate most in drama are always "the good guys vs. the good guys." *Ordinary People* is an unflinching story about decent people coming to terms with a loss they don't completely understand, each character doing his or her best to cope. At a time in popular culture when "reality TV" celebrates those who are anything but real, *Ordinary People* is a quiet look inward at the genuine everyday people who make up most of our society. Their ordinary story is as worth telling as the extraordinary one.

During rehearsals, I enjoyed watching the "empathy machine" evolve as the actors came to know their characters. I empathize with all of them and think you will too.




