On Stage...

Marty Howrey (Claudine Hampton): Active on both sides of the lights for the past ten years, Marty has appeared in a variety of roles. She says that the people (those she works with and those she portrays) are what keep her coming back. Off stage she co-stars with Dave as a parent of John (a sophomore at ISU) and Meg (an apprentice with the Joffrey Ballet).

Tricia Reed (LuAnn Hampton): Tricia is making her third appearance on the Red Mask stage and she has been involved with a large variety of Danville Light Opera performances. She is a second semester freshman at DACC majoring in Communications and she hopes to transfer to Southern Illinois University under the major of Cinematic Photography.

Edward S. Sant (Billy Bob Wortman): Ed's interest in theater goes back to 1977 when he ran props for the Red Mask production of *Janus*. Since then, Ed has done much backstage work and appeared onstage many times. Red Mask credits include *Gingerbread Lady*, *You Can't Take it With You*, and *Squabbles*. His DLO credits include *She Loves Me*, and most recently as the second comic in *Sugar Babies*. Ed divides his acting life with his real life as Manager of Precision Photo in the Village Mall.

Chuck Pundt (Skip Hampton): Chuck returns to the stage after two years absence, "Because I work evenings," he says. "But I'm glad to be back." He currently works for Clem the Cleaner but is pursuing a career as a Danville firefighter. His free time is spent working as a volunteer firefighter for Bismark, and now, with Red Mask. When asked if he learned any lessons while researching this role, he laughs. "Yeah, stay away from the Thunderbird wine. It ain't worth it kids."

Kurt Finley (Dale Laverty): A graduate of Catlin High School, where he performed in *The Sting*, *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*, and *Let it Rain*. Kurt is making his second appearance on the Red Mask stage following last fall's production of *The Mousetrap*. Kurt is attending DACC and is employed by the sports department at the Commercial-News.

Leonard "Sonny" Downing (Rufe Phelps): Sonny is pleased to be making his debut on the Red Mask stage, after having worked on set construction for several Red Mask productions. He appeared in the last four Sunshine II musicals and one DLO production. He is employed by Bohn Heat Transfer and his wife Sandy is an employee of the VA Medical Center. They have one son and two daughters.

Larry L. Finley (Olin Potts): This is his first appearance on the Red Mask stage. His most recent appearance was with DLO in *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers*. He has been active with Sunshine II Productions and DLO since 1984. The shows he enjoyed most were Sunshine II's *South Pacific* as Commander Harbison, and DLO's production of *Where's Charley?* as Sir Francis. Larry lives in rural Fairmount with his wife Jean. He is an Industrial Education instructor at Oakwood High School.

Terry Walters (Red Grover): Last year on a beach and this year in the desert area of Texas, we wonder where Terry's travels will take us next year? With his work with the State of Illinois, he is used to hearing the complaints at Red's.

Dave Downing (Corky Oberlander): Dave is happy (and thankful) to be onstage for a Red Mask production, after almost surviving the backstage crew for *Noises Off*. His last Red Mask performance was in last season's spring production of *The Importance of Being Earnest* as the Rev. Dr. Chausible. Dave has been active on and offstage, the last four seasons for Sunshine II Productions as well as last fall's *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers* with DLO. "Corky" and his lovely wife Alice have four children and one beautiful granddaughter. Dave is employed by Illinois Bell as a Systems Tech.

John Dowers (Milo Crawford): This marks John's sixth appearance on the Red Mask stage. He was seen last fall in *The Mousetrap* as the colorful Christopher Wren. He hopes to someday play Fred Legg's son in the male version of *Steel Magnolias*. John works in the Circulation Department of the Commercial-News and lunches frequently at Jocko's Pizza Inn.

Sherry Norton (Charmaine): This is her first Red Mask adult production, although she has participated in many children's shows. She is a sophomore at DHS where she is involved in *Contemporaires*, *Chorus*, and as a photographer for the yearbook.
