

"I want a Mom that will last forever I want a mom to make it all better I want a mom that will last forever I want a mom who will love me whatever." -Cyndi Lauper



#### JEAN LEWIS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

**N** amed after the founder of Red Mask Children's Theater, the Jean Lewis Scholarship is an annual award of \$750 to a student planning a career in the theater, performing arts, or a directly related area such as speech or radio/television. Performing artists will be asked to audition as part of their application. Along with a completed application, those seeking the scholarship funds must submit two letters of recommendation. Completed applications must be postmarked by April 8, 2010.
