

FROM THE DIRECTOR

Wow, as a first-time director I managed to jump into the deep end with both feet. Everyone is familiar with the story of *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*. In fact, most of you probably read it in high school. Jeffrey Hatcher's adaption, while staying very true to Stevenson's novella, is such a unique take on the story that I can practically guarantee that you have never seen the likes of it before. Traditionally, Jekyll and Hyde are viewed as two sides of the same coin. Light and dark, good and evil. The duality of man. The Angel and the Demon. What Hatcher proposes, through the actors here tonight, is that no man can be inherently all good or all evil. The nature of man, like all things, is not black and white. It's made up of many shades of gray. Dr. Henry Jekyll is not, cannot be, pure goodness. And Mr. Edward Hyde is not, cannot be, a pure manifestation of evil. Maybe they are about 70/30 and 30/70 respectively. And perhaps that scale will move even further as our evening progresses.

I would be remiss if I did not mention the talented group of actors who have come together to serve as our guides through this tale. Occasionally during rehearsals, I got the feeling that maybe they weren't seeing the same vision as me (I base that on the fact that I often saw looks on faces the seemed to imply that I was crazier than any character on the stage.) But when it clicked, it was magical. And I can't say enough about my hyenas, each playing multiple roles, which only serves to deepen the question we all must answer, who is Edward Hyde?

So please, join us as we enter the mind of a man who is descending into madness, and see what is on the other side.
