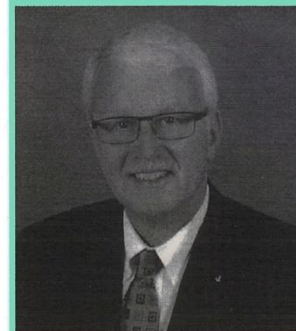

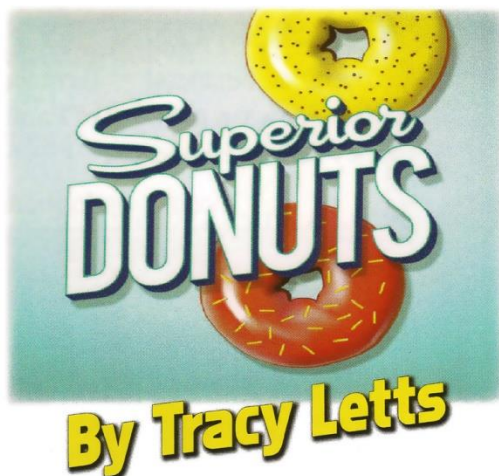

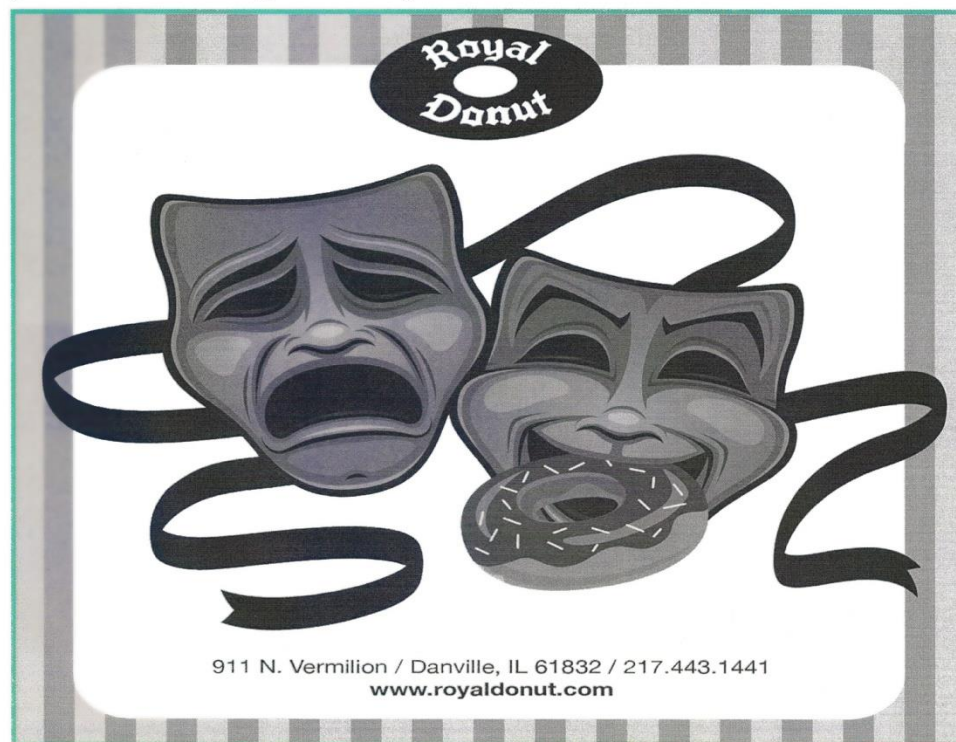


## FROM THE DIRECTOR
